Composition of Tenure and Promotion Committee

1. Membership on the college's Tenure and Promotion Committee shall be limited to tenured faculty holding a regular faculty appointment as Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor.
2. The committee shall be composed of eight members. Each of the five departments shall elect a faculty member from within the department. The three remaining faculty members shall be elected using a college wide ballot. There shall be no more than two members from any one department within the college.
3. Only tenure-track faculty are eligible to vote for Tenure and Promotion Committee members.
4. The chairperson of the committee shall be elected by the members of the committee to serve for one year.
5. Department Chairpersons, faculty who are candidates for promotion, or faculty whose family members are candidates for promotion or tenure shall not serve on the committee.
6. Elected members shall serve for two consecutive years.
7. Votes for promotion to a given rank must be cast by faculty who possess that rank or a higher rank. In cases where there are fewer than three members who are eligible to vote, the dean, after consultation with the voting members, will appoint additional members to the committee from other departments with related interests.
8. For any reason, if an elected member cannot complete his/her term, an elected replacement will complete the remaining period.
